As a requirement for entry, all Market Steer, Market Lamb, Market Hog, Broiler Chicken Pens, Meat Turkey, Market Goat, Market Eggs, Market Rabbit, Dairy Cattle, Dairy Goat and Pygmy Goat exhibitors are required to participate in a California State Fair certified Quality Assurance and Ethics Awareness Training prior to July 2, 2010.

High school agriculture teachers, 4-H, and Grange representatives who have completed one of the trainings at one of their professional development events and are approved by the California State Fair may serve as official Quality Assurance and Ethics Awareness Training instructors. If you cannot attend one of these trainings, please contact Cal Expo at the number below to see if a person in your local area is qualified to hold a training.
